'An exciting and different trip'.. is assured on the forthcoming visit to Armourgeddon - a military vehicle driving experience centre near Husbands Bosworth! Don't worry, as we won't be expecting you to drive a tank!.. although this could be arranged if you fancy having a go!..



With plenty to see and do including several viewing areas together with a substantial museum housing around 40 various military vehicles, also with many artefacts and memorabilia. Several of these date from World War 2 and many 'earn their keep' being hired out for film, TV and PR work – so you will see a few film stars!! (from films such as 'Evita' 'Saving Private Ryan' 'Fury' etc.!!)



Also there is a café on site and several seating areas where you can watch the action from - while enjoying a cuppa and light refreshments if you require. As well as a viewing gallery inside there are several picnic tables outside together with the recently opened 'Normandy Café'!.. This recreates the atmosphere of a French café complete with cobbled street, shutters and canopy with bistro tables to sit at and the addition of a military convoy passing by!!...

This inaugural trip will be on Wednesday 31st May, departing the Lutterworth area approx.. 9:30 to spend the morning at Armourgeddon. Afterwards we will continue on to 'The Wharf' canal-side pub at Welford for lunchtime.
